Science: Unit: Materials in Our World

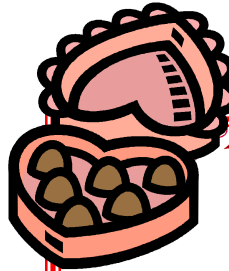

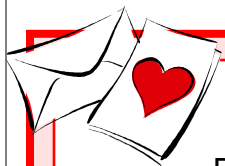
