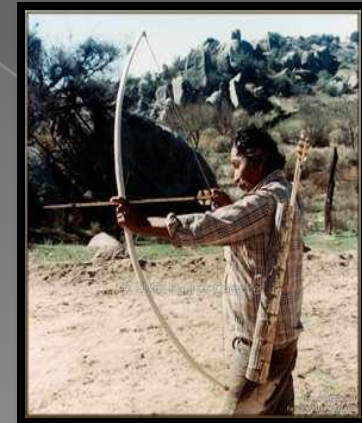
Shelter
