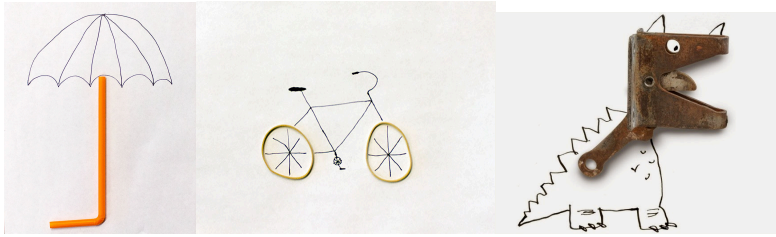

December: Found Object Illustration



Role: As an artist, your goal is to have your audience view things from different points of view. Your goal is to transform an ordinary, common object into something new in a simple yet convincing illustration using line

Objective: You will be able to transform an object into something new in an illustration using line and shape.

Procedure: There are two ways of doing this assignment: 1) Chose an object and lay it on a piece of white paper. Draw around the object then photograph it. All lines should be traced in ink. Print out the photo and hand it in. 2) Chose an object to transform and take a picture of it on a piece of white paper. Upload the picture to a computer and print it out. Draw around the photograph then hand it in. All lines should be traced

<p>Composition</p> <p>*The drawing should fill the page or “run” off the edges. All objects should be grounded. *It is drawn from an interesting point of view.</p>				
<p>Accuracy</p> <p>*It should be easily recognizable without labels and be depicted accurately. *The drawing should have correct proportions, perspective, and textures.</p>				
<p>Creativity</p> <p>*The drawing should demonstrate a unique level of originality, innovative thought and research. *The artist’s ability to observe the objects with care is evident.</p>				
<p>Effort</p> <p>*The drawings appear to be very challenging and a considerable amount of time has been spent on them. *No parts of the drawing appear to be unfinished.</p>				
<p>Craftsmanship</p> <p>*The drawing is completed with a great deal of patience and pride. *The student was concerned with the process of creating a good drawing rather than just finishing it.</p>
