

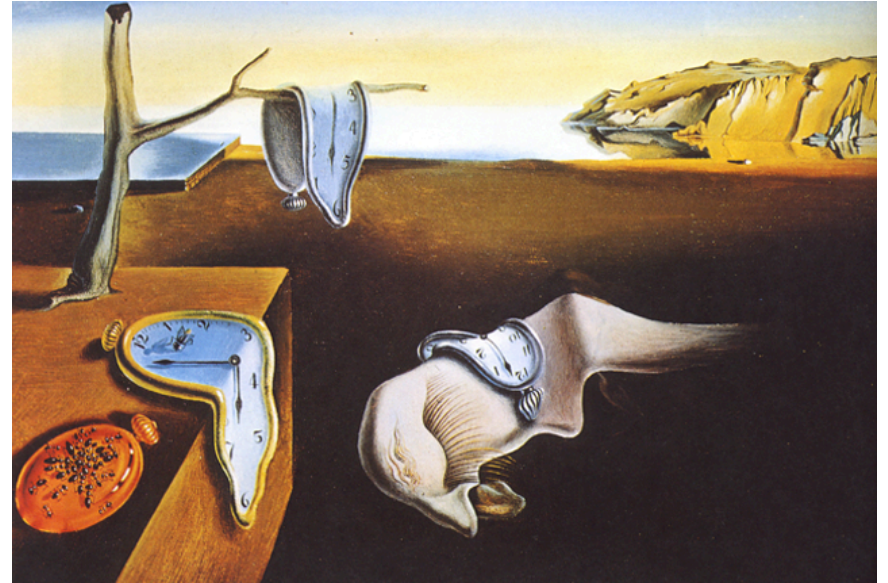

January Process Journal Assignment: Creative Writing

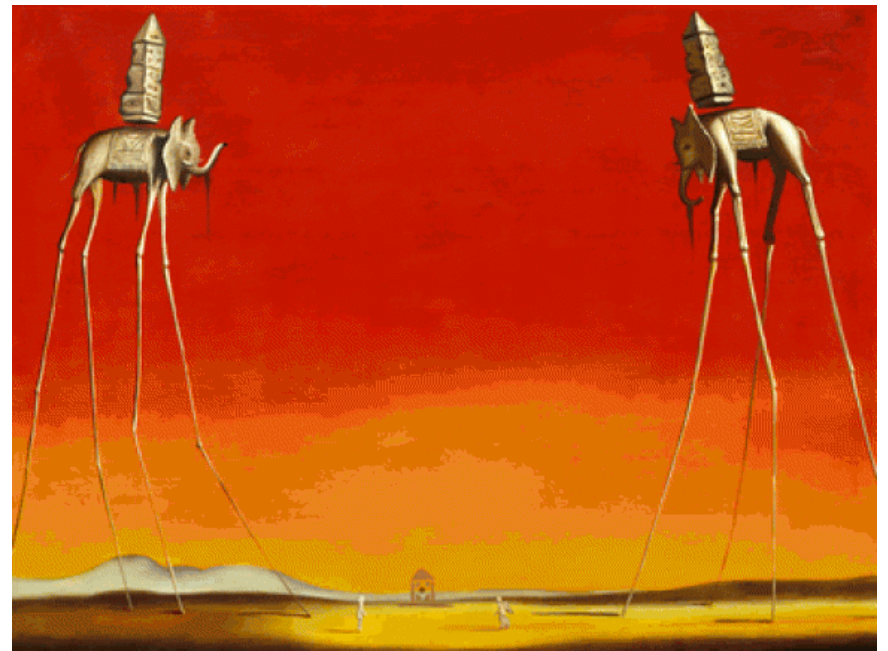
- **Role:** You work for The Salvador Dali Museum in St. Petersburg, FL. You have been asked you to write a short story based on one of Dali's pieces. The piece of artwork is your "illustration" and will give you all the information to build from, but the work should be fiction.
- **Objective:** You will create a story based on a piece of artwork by Salvador Dali using evidence from the painting to support your writing.
- **Procedure:** Chose a painting from the Scholastic Magazine on Salvador Dali or the Salvador Dali Museum website (<http://thedali.org/>). Write a 2-3 paragraph (approximately 7 sentences) short story based on the painting. Use evidence from the painting to support your story, but be creative. Include a setting, characters, and a plot in your story.
- **Grading:** Below is a check list for the January Process Journal Assignment. Each category is worth 10 points. Hand this paper in with your assignment.

	Is the piece by Salvador Dali?
	Is it written in complete sentences?
	Is it legible?

	Are capital letters and punctuation used?
	Is there a setting in the story?
	Is there at least one character in the story?
	Is there a plot in the story?
	Is there evidence supporting the story in the painting?
