II. EDITING THE LINKS

- 1. Deleting a button
 - a) Click "Configure" on drop-down list immediately above the button you wish to remove. Click "Delete." (NOTE: YOU CANNOT UNDO THIS!)



- 2. Moving a button:
 - a) Click "Configure" on drop-down list immediately above the button you wish to move. Click "Move left" or "Move right."

3. Modifying a button

- 4. Adding a button
 - a) Choose your component type:
 - Topic component like a subject heading; this link will take you to another list of subtopics. Used for grouping like items together. [see figure 1]
 - Query component runs a specified query on items in your catalog, such as searching for all holiday books, etc. [see figure 2]
 - Link component launches a website or other external program. [see figure 3]
 - b) Click one of the <u>configuration links</u>.
