

Using the BibStats Utility

1. Make sure your database is selected.

2. Specify a date range, if you wish.

3. Choose the number of titles you wish to see (For example, top 10, top 50, top 100 - the default is 30)

4. Select the types of transactions you wish to include.

5. If your collection is split into groups, you may specify only fiction, only AV, etc.

6. You may also specify patron criteria – for example, you could just see a particular grade level.
