called an optical printer)....

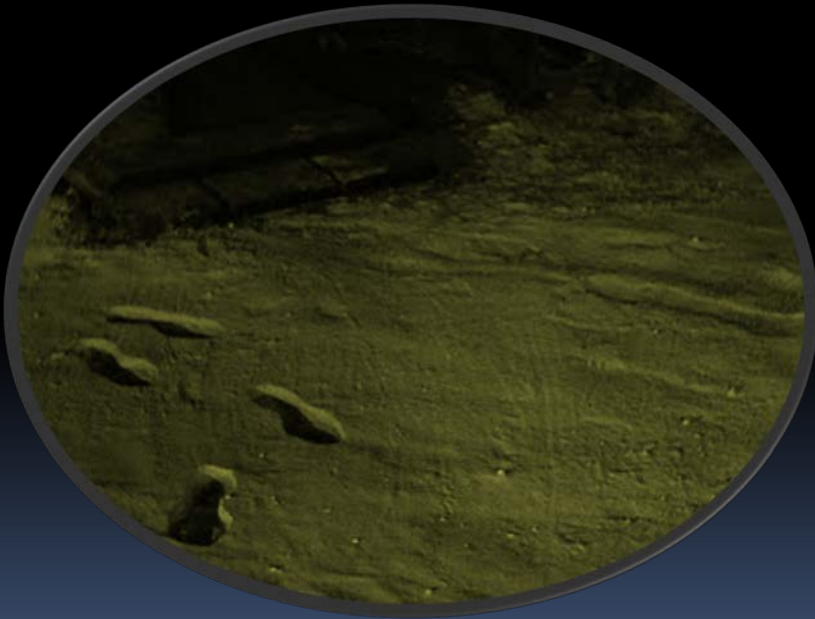
...created many of the
