THE WASHED-OUT LOOK MAKES THE FILM SEEM MORE AUTHENTIC.




The Battle Scenes

TOM HANKS IS EXCELLENT AS MILLER.




HIS "EVERYMAN" QUALITIES EMBODY THE CITIZEN SOLDIER.

CAPARZO'S COMPASSION MAKES HIM DROP HIS GUARD.






