We know the importance of completing homework assignments as it gives our students the practice they need to reinforce the skills that are learned during the school day. Students who do not complete homework assignments may be assigned to "homework help lunch" where they will eat and complete their missing assignments in a quiet, supervised location.



Revised Attendance Policy

New York State Education Law states that all students between the ages of six and seventeen must receive full-time instruction. Consistent attendance at school is a significant factor in achieving productive academic and social outcomes. Our Board of Education Policy states that we must notify you in writing at a certain number of total school-year absences (7, 14, 21, and 28) and work with you to improve poor attendance patterns. Additionally, Education Law requires that a child returning to school from an absence bring a written excuse signed by a parent describing the cause and date(s) of the absence. The student must present the excuse to his homeroom teacher within three days of his absence.
