Endpoint-where something ends, where measurement begins
Overlap- to extend over, or cover partly
Ruler- tool uses to measure length
Centimeter- (cm) unit of length measure
Meter- $(\mathrm{m})$ unit of length measure $=100 \mathrm{~cm}$
Hash Mark- the marks on a ruler or other measurement tool
Number Line- a line marked with evenly spaced intervals
Estimate- an approximation of the value or quantity of a number
Benchmark- a number that is a "round" number, like multiples of 10
Tape Diagram- visual models that use rectangles to represent the parts of a ratio using the same unit.
