

MATH 8 STATE TEST REVIEW TUTORING

The Math 8 department is offering two options for additional review for the state test. Students are encouraged to attend sessions offered by their current math teacher, but may attend sessions with a different teacher if necessary. *All sessions are held in the classrooms of the teachers listed.*

Option 1: Saturday, April 14th 9:00 – 12:00 (Stonitsch, Smith, Condon)

- The entire review (multiple choice and short response) is presented in ONE session
- Students must have own transportation to and from school
- Students should be dropped off and picked up at the LIBRARY door (left side of building, toward the front)
- This session is ideal for students who have other after school activities during the week (ex. Sports)

Option 2: After school 3:20 – 5:10

Mon, April 16 th Session I Stonitsch, Condon	Tues, April 17 th Session I Andrews, Wirick, Smith	Wed, April 18 th NONE	Thurs, April 19 th Session II Andrews, Wirick, Smith	Fri, April 20 th Session II Stonitsch, Condon
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- Review is spread out over both sessions –Session I is multiple choice, Session II is short response
- The late bus is available for transportation home at 5:20 on all days
- Students can only attend one of each session (don't attend two Session I classes, as they are the same questions)
- Snack available

Incentives:

- Additional review and practice with test questions
- FIVE POINTS added to their 4th marking period average (2 points if a student only attends Session I OR Session II and NOT BOTH)
- OPT OUT students are still invited to attend the session so they can practice for their final exam in June and get the 5 points. Algebra students are NOT invited to attend, but will have another opportunity for bonus points during Regents Review

After-break refresher - Monday, April 30th, 3:15 – 5:10

- Students are invited to attend an additional review session to practice additional questions and strategies
- An additional 2 points will be awarded to those students
- Located in Mr. Condon and Ms. Wirick's rooms

Students do NOT have to sign up in order to attend, but there will be a sign-in sheet when students attend.

Students who attend are expected to do the work and behave appropriately. Students who do not do work or who behave inappropriately will not earn the above points and may be asked to leave early.
