## 3. Navajo Code Talkers


Navajo Code Talkers were WWII secret agents who used a secret code based on their native language. American marines used radios to communicate which could be intercepted by the Japanese so the messages needed to be put through a code machine. But there was no time to use a code machine in the middle of a battle. The problem was solved by using Navajo Code Talkers who would make it possible to relay a message in minutes using their native language that no Japanese soldier was able to understand or identify (since Navajo wasn't a written language it could only be learned from a Navajo Indian.
