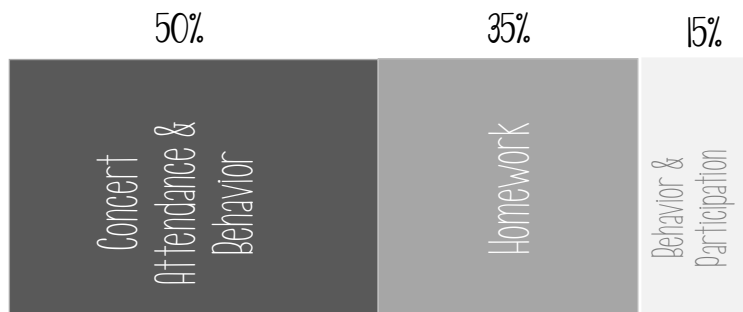

FOOD & DRINK POLICY

Food and drinks are not allowed in my classroom, with the exception of water. Due to the performance and moving nature of the course, food and drink can cause a distraction.

Concert Attendance

Concerts are our opportunity to demonstrate all that we have worked towards in the classes leading up.

Since performance opportunities are the main focus of our daily classes, concerts will be mandatory for all chorus members to attend. This will count as 50% of your average in the 2nd and 4th marking periods.

HOMEWORK POLICY

Most work will be able to be completed in class if students use their time wisely.

Homework must be submitted by the deadline. If a student submits work early, I will grade the work and return it to the student where they can then fix any errors and resubmit for final grading. This must all be completed by the original deadline.

ABSENCES AND GRADES

For the performances held throughout the year, uniformity is held at high importance. Students must wear dress clothes for each concert.

Students must wear all black; black tops, black bottoms, & black dresses will be required.

When choosing what to wear for the concert, please be mindful of appropriateness and length. Concert clothes should be more formal than everyday wear.

If you do not have concert clothing, please come speak to me privately so that I can ensure you receive what you need for the performances.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Electronic devices should be kept in students backpacks. Devices should not be out during class, unless otherwise instructed by the teacher or with permission. This is a district wide policy and will be strictly enforced.
