# What is REACH???

REACH is an afterschool program designed and developed to help your child grow and mature academically, socially, and emotionally to help reach their full potential. We focus on their character, health and wellbeing, and education.

REACH operates Monday - Thursday on a weekly basis from 2:45 to 5:45. REACH encompasses three main components in our daily routine consisting of **Academic Tutoring, Enrichments, and Recreation.** REACH employees comprise of Waverly school day teachers/aides and other educational programs from outside sources. REACH works directly with the Waverly School District and Waverly Community. Parents are encouraged to become involved with what their child is doing in REACH. REACH is equal opportunity program for all Waverly School District Students in grades 3 through 8.

REACH will start Monday September 30<sup>th</sup> and end Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup> and will consist of four sessions that are 8 weeks long.

- Session 1: September 30<sup>th</sup> to November 21<sup>st</sup>
- Session 2: December 2<sup>nd</sup> to January 30<sup>th</sup>
- Session 3: February 3<sup>rd</sup> to March 26<sup>th</sup>
- Session 4: March 30<sup>th</sup> to May 21<sup>st</sup>

# About REACH

## Daily Routine



- REACH is from 2:45 - 5:45 Monday through Thursday.
- Students report to the cafeteria when school lets out.
- Students have Snack, Tutoring, Enrichment, and Recreation daily.
- Students can be picked up at any time during the program.
- Students have the option of riding a bus home at the end of the program with designated drop off spots.

## REACH Components



- **Academic Tutoring-** Students will do classwork, study, work on projects, get extra help from teachers, or practice academic skills.
- **Enrichment-** Students will explore different programs using hands on activities geared to enhance their critical thinking skills. Programs vary depending on student interest and teach availability.
- **Recreation:** Students use this time to exercise and play various games. Focus is on physical health and fun!
